

Graduation

As previously mentioned, the Master Thesis is usually conducted after the completion of all compulsory and elective courses of the CME Program.

It is comprised of **35 ECTS** divided into Thesis Preparation (**5 ECTS**) and the Thesis itself (**30 ECTS**).

Before starting your thesis, make sure to attend Thesis Preparation on brightspace under *CME5100* and visit the department where you can find the Graduation Form, which provides all practical information, in Sandra's office.



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





